### **Record Breaking Feline Adoptions at Woods Humane Society**

(San Luis Obispo, CA – July 2010)

85 of Woods Humane Society's cats and kittens found loving new homes in June, breaking the shelter's previous adoption record of 62 feline adoptions set in September of 2009.

It is challenging to place felines into loving new homes due to the surplus of unwanted cats throughout San Luis Obispo County. There are simply too many cats and not enough homes. Compounding this issue is the fact that we are also working through a busy kitten season. For the most part, adopters tend to gravitate toward kitten adoptions, while overlooking the wonderful older (6+ months) adult cats.

June is National Adopt a Shelter Cat Month and interestingly, the adult cats at WHS received the same level of attention and adoption rate as our kitten population. This is also the first time that WHS' feline population has dropped below 100 cats in the entire facility. Unfortunately, the shelter's feline adoption program will return to capacity within the next two weeks.
